Submission form

- Is this a Companion/Implementation Sketch? { Emerging Technologies | Guerilla Studio | Computer Animation Festival | Art Gallery | Paper Implementation Sketch }
 - Authors of accepted Emerging Technologies, Guerilla Studio, Computer Animation Festival, and Art Gallery submissions are highly encouraged to submit a companion sketch. These sketches replace what used to be called Emerging Technologies and Art Gallery presentations.
 - Authors of accepted Papers are encouraged to submit a companion implementation sketch. These companion sketches will be reviewed by the Sketches Jury under special consideration of the already-accepted piece.
- If you made a selection above, please enter the Online ID of the accepted submission
- Sketch Title
- Abstract (300 words or less)
- Check if this is a Work in Progress Sketch proposal.
 - We added a special "work in progress" tag for unusual and inspirational ideas that challenge assumptions and broaden our concept of computer graphics and interactive techniques. Submit fresh, half-baked, and odd ideas that are likely to generate a lot of discussion. It is perfectly fine, and encouraged, to branch out into areas where you have little or no background. Work in progress submissions follow the usual submission format but will be reviewed by the Sketches Jury using separate criteria.
- Please select one or more keywords from the following list. Your keyword(s) will be used in assigning your submission to the most appropriate jurors. Please list them in prioritized order based on their relevance to your sketch.
 - You must enter at least one Keyword, but no more than four.
- Name and affiliation of all collaborators (In this format: first author's name, first author's affiliation, second author's name, second author's affiliation, etc.)
- Additional email
 - Email address (just one is supported) that will be copied on all communications from SIGGRAPH 2006 regarding this submission.
- Summary - 30-word summary suitable for Advance Program promotion.
 - Please see SIGGRAPH 2005 Sketches program sessions online for example summary text (e.g., any sketch presented in the Twisted Perspectives session at SIGGRAPH 2005).
- Sketch Thumbnail
 - You are required to upload a 150x150 pixel JPG image that can act as a visual reminder of the sketch. If accepted, your thumbnail image will also be presented along with a brief summary of your sketch on the SIGGRAPH 2006 web site.
- The Sketch
 - Once you have been assigned an online ID for this submission (sketches_onnn), include this ID in the text of your Sketch beside the title. Then return to this form and upload the PDF for your Sketch submission in this field. Note that any PDF longer than a single 8.5 inch x 11 inch page

will be rejected.

- Supplemental video (Optional, but encouraged).
 - All submitters are encouraged to provide video demonstrations of their projects, if available. Up to five minutes of video may be uploaded, in one or more separate files. We can only accommodate videos in QuickTime MPEG-4 or DivX Version 5 formats. The total length of all videos should not exceed five minutes.
 - Remember that the total size of all uploaded files, including your Sketch PDF and video or other supplemental materials, must not exceed 40 MB.
- OPTIONAL: You may submit up to three supporting materials.
 - Supplemental materials can be QuickTime MPEG-4 or DivX Version 5 videos, TIFF, JPEG, PNG, or GIF images. Supporting documentation should be in PDF format, up to three pages long, and should contain mostly captioned figures or tables. Please refrain from submitting an expanded paper; sketches must be self-contained at 1 page.
 - Important: The total size of all your submitted materials including Sketch PDF and video must not exceed 40 MB.

アップロードはたいていうまくいかないものです。以下のガイドラインを参考にしてください。

ギリギリまで待たない (Don't wait until the last minute) 送信システムは強力なものをつかってますが、それでも限界があります。去年は最後の30分で5GBが転送されようとしたためサーバが落ちました。こうならないようにしてください。

はやめに何度か (Upload early and often) 送信が完了しても書き換え、追加をすることはできます。あとからムービーをアップしたり、文章を校正することも可能です。

インターネットのコントロールはしません (We do not control the internet) テストでは20Mbpsの回線からのアップロードは5kbpsに、2Gbpsの回線からのアップロードは10kbpsに落ちました。過密な状況ではアップロードが失敗することもあります。とにかく早めに送ってください。

プログレスバーはうそつきです (The progress bar says you're done, but then nothing happens) IE のプログレスバーはうそをつきます。バーでは終わってるように見えるのに10時間かかることもあります。お茶でも飲みながらお待ちください。

大きなファイルをアップロードしないでください (Don't try to upload too much) アップロードファイルに制限があるプログラムもあります。例えば Sketch への投稿データは合計40MBまでです。
