## Guidelines for Applicants

### 1 DURATION OF TRAVEL:

From September 25 to 29, 2017 (Planned)

※It would be slightly changed because of crowded flight or unforeseen situation.

※Several professors of JAIST will travel together with participating students.

### 2 NUMBER OF STUDENTS SELECTED: 6 students

### 3 APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the all following requirements:

- ① Doctoral students of JAIST
- ② Those who are recommended by their supervisor.
- ③ Those who have English proficiency to join the workshop.
- ④ Those who have joined Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research(PAS) and Liability Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (LSR).
- ⑤ Those who can buy travel insurance at their own expenses.

### 4 SUPPORTED EXPENSES:

- Expenses for flight tickets, accommodations and daily allowances will be paid into a participant' s bank account via direct deposit according to JAIST regulations.
- Each participant has to pay the necessary expenses by themselves according to the guidance by the professor in charge.

### 5 HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are required to submit the following documents to the International Project Section after getting approval from their supervisor.

- ① Application Form
- ② Copies of the receipts for the payment of PAS and LSR

### 6 APPLICATION DEADLINE

4 p.m., July 14, 2017

### 7 CRITERION FOR SELECTION:

Applicants are selected based on their specialty, reasons for applying and English proficiency.

## 8 RESULT NOTIFICATION

Each applicant is notified of the result by the middle of July.

## 9 SUBMISSION OF REPORT

Students who join the workshop must submit a report on the prescribed form within one month after the workshop.

## 10 OTHERS

- If students taking L224 or L226 join this workshop, the students will be regarded as having experience-based learning in the international exchange events of those courses. (Even if students have not registered for the course, they can apply for/join the workshop.)
- The details on procedures for travel to Thailand will be informed to successful applicants after the selection of participants.
